1. Welcome to eBook Reader

Welcome to **eBook Reader**, the best viewer and organizer for electronic books for The Nokia 9210 Communicator.

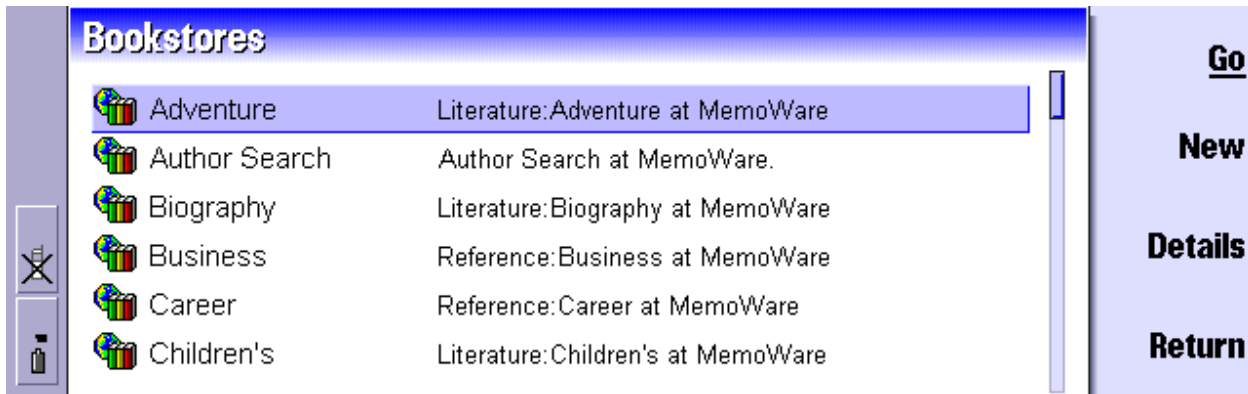


With eBook Reader you can download and read eBooks from Web-based eBook stores. Your eBooks reside in a personal library located on your Communicator. eBook Reader has three main components:

1. **Bookstores**, where you download eBooks.
2. **My Library**, where you organize your eBooks and choose books to read.
3. **Reader**, where you read the eBooks.

2. Using Bookstores

Bookstores is a place where you download eBooks from stores on the Internet. Bookstores requires an Internet connection.

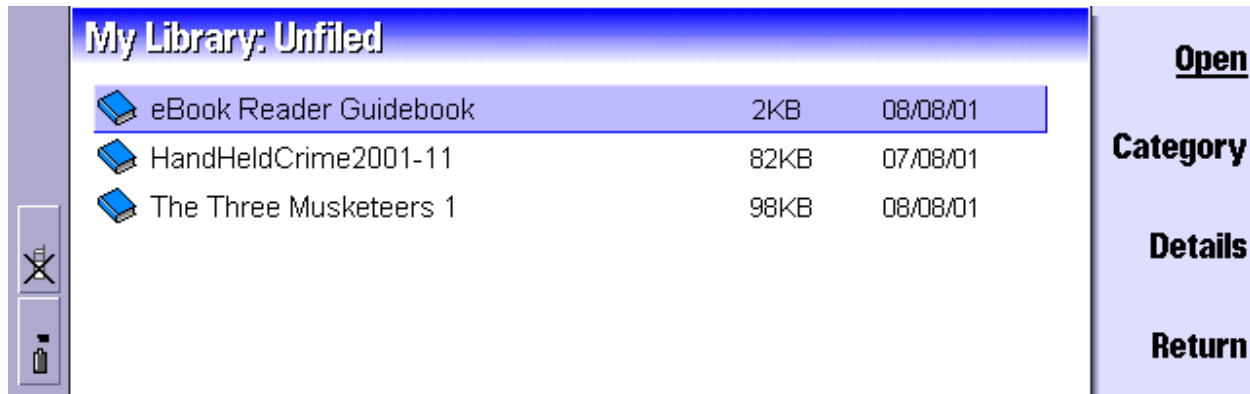


When you enter Bookstores, you see a list of Web sites. Select a site and press **Go** button or press Enter.

Select a site and press **Details** button to see details about the site and edit them.

3. Using My Library

My Library is an organizer for your eBooks. When you download an eBook it appears in My Library.



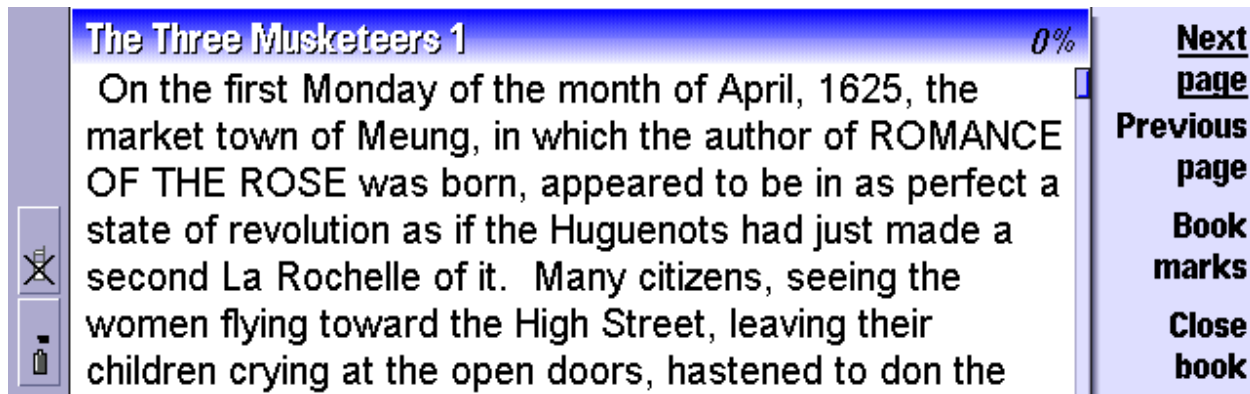
My Library displays names, sizes and the last access dates of your eBooks. You can view the entire contents of My Library or only books in categories you choose. To choose a category for display press the **Category** button. You can also sort your books in several ways. To choose a method for sorting go to **View > Sorted by** on the menu.

eBook Reader comes with a set of built-in categories. Press the **Category** button to define your own categories. Select an eBook in the list and press the **Details** button to view details about the book and to assign the book to a category.

Select an eBook in the list and press **Open** button to open the book in Reader.

4. Using Reader

Reader displays the content of your eBooks. When you return to a book you have read before, the eBook Reader opens the book to the last page you read.



To go to the next page of a book, click the **Next page** button or press Enter or Page Down.

To bookmark a page select **Bookmarks > Add bookmark** on the menu. Later, you can use the **Bookmarks** button to return to that page.

You can enlarge the text by pressing Zoom keys.

Use **Edit > Find** on the menu to search for text in a book.

Use **View > Show title** and **View > Full screen** on the menu to enlarge the text area.

5. Supported Formats

eBook Reader supports the most popular Palm DOC (Aportis) format of electronic books.

eBook Reader also supports text (TXT) and HTML (no graphics, text only) documents.
